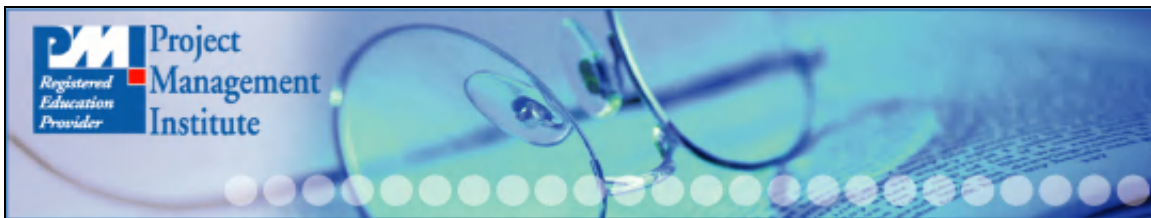

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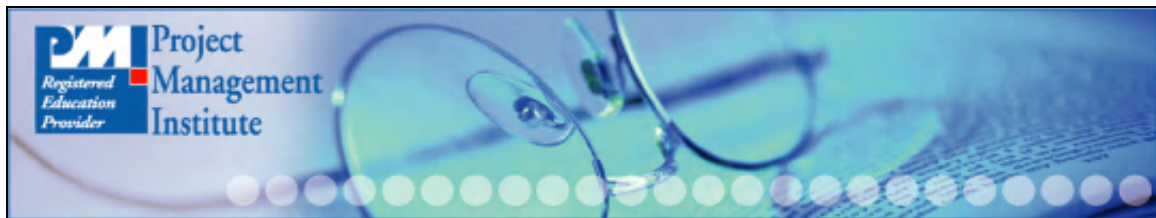
1 Program Value

As this training is based on PMI® best practices, some techniques will be included such as Earned Value technique, Pert Analysis and Critical Path Analysis.

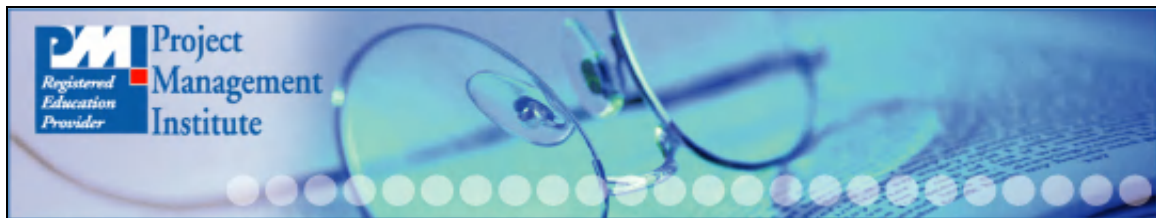
